

REDEFINING THE ROLE OF YOUR LOCAL POLICE

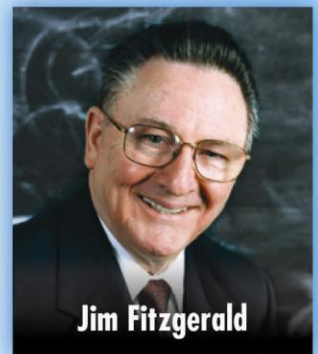


**SUPPORT YOUR
